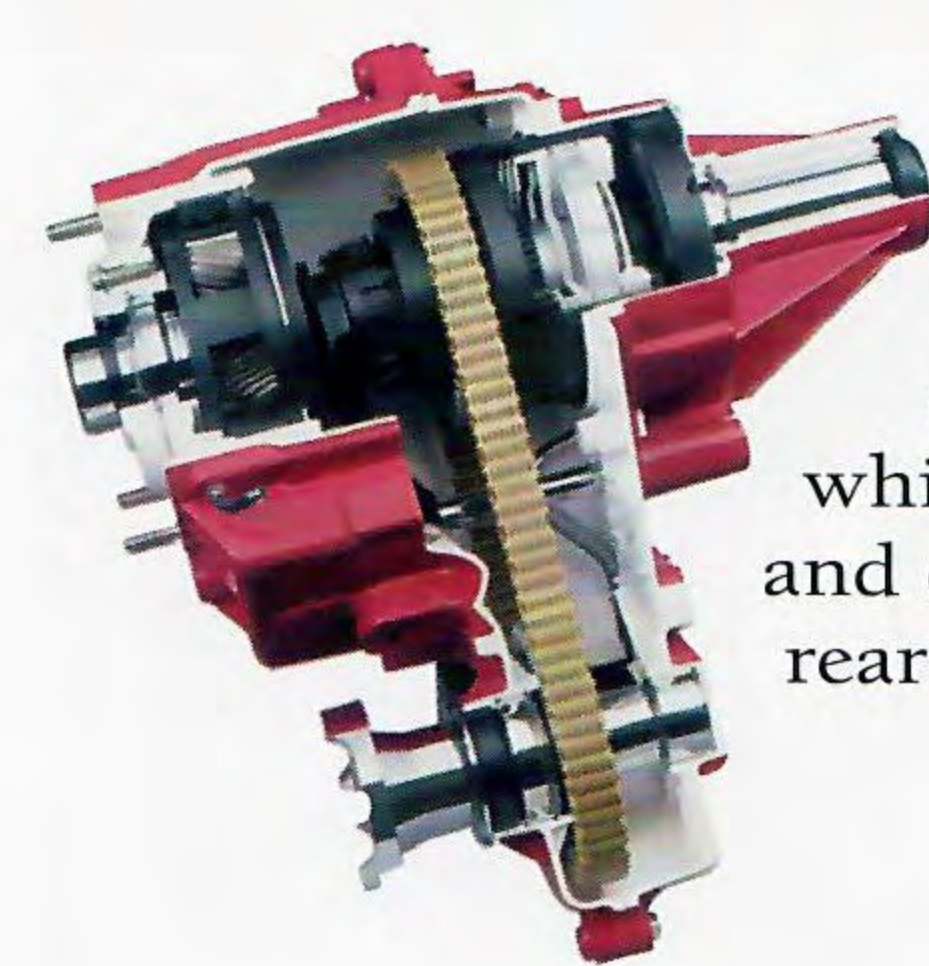
QUADRA-DRIVE™

The all-new Quadra-Drive System transfers torque rear to front and side to side to maintain traction and control.

In normal driving, it sends engine torque through the new Quadra-Trac II™ (NV247) on-demand transfer case* to the all-new rear Vari-Lok™ progressive axle.† The moment a rear wheel loses grip, however, a gerotor coupling in the rear axle transfers torque to the other rear wheel. If that wheel cannot continue momentum, a gerotor pump in the transfer case sends that torque to the all-new front Vari-Lok progressive axle. There, a gerotor coupling is capable of transferring 100 percent of the developed engine torque to just one wheel. This reaction and torque transfer is continuously monitored and maintained by Quadra-Drive regardless of which wheel experiences loss of traction — and it is done progressively, silently and smoothly.

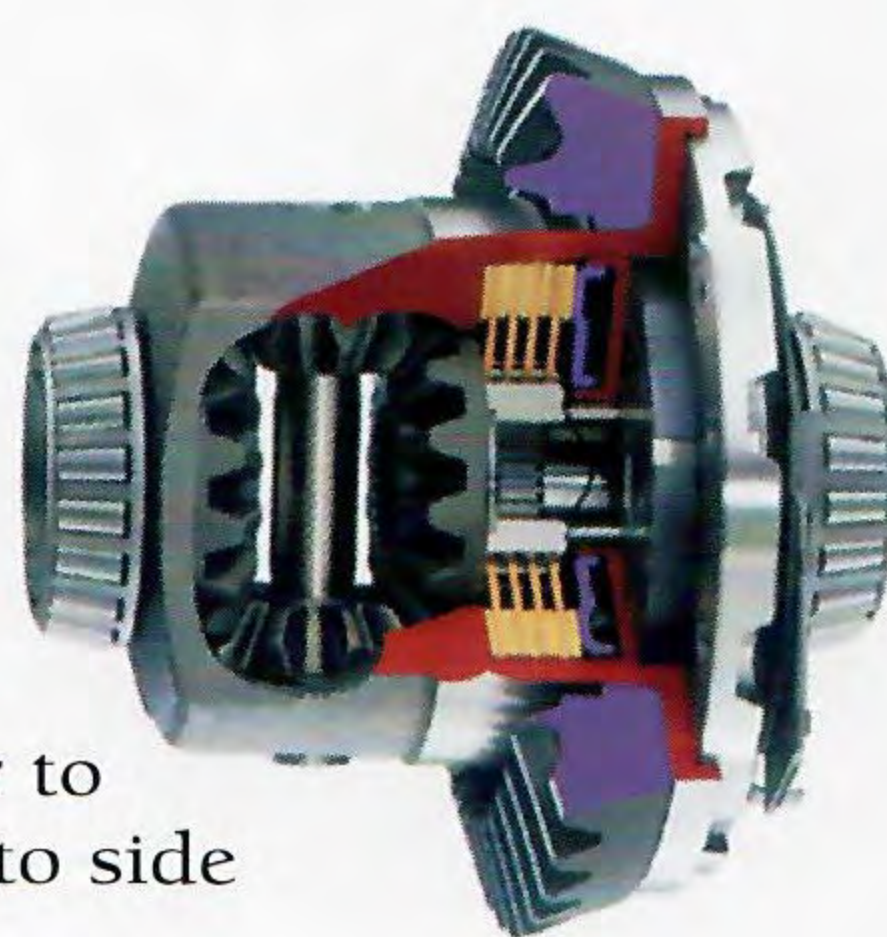

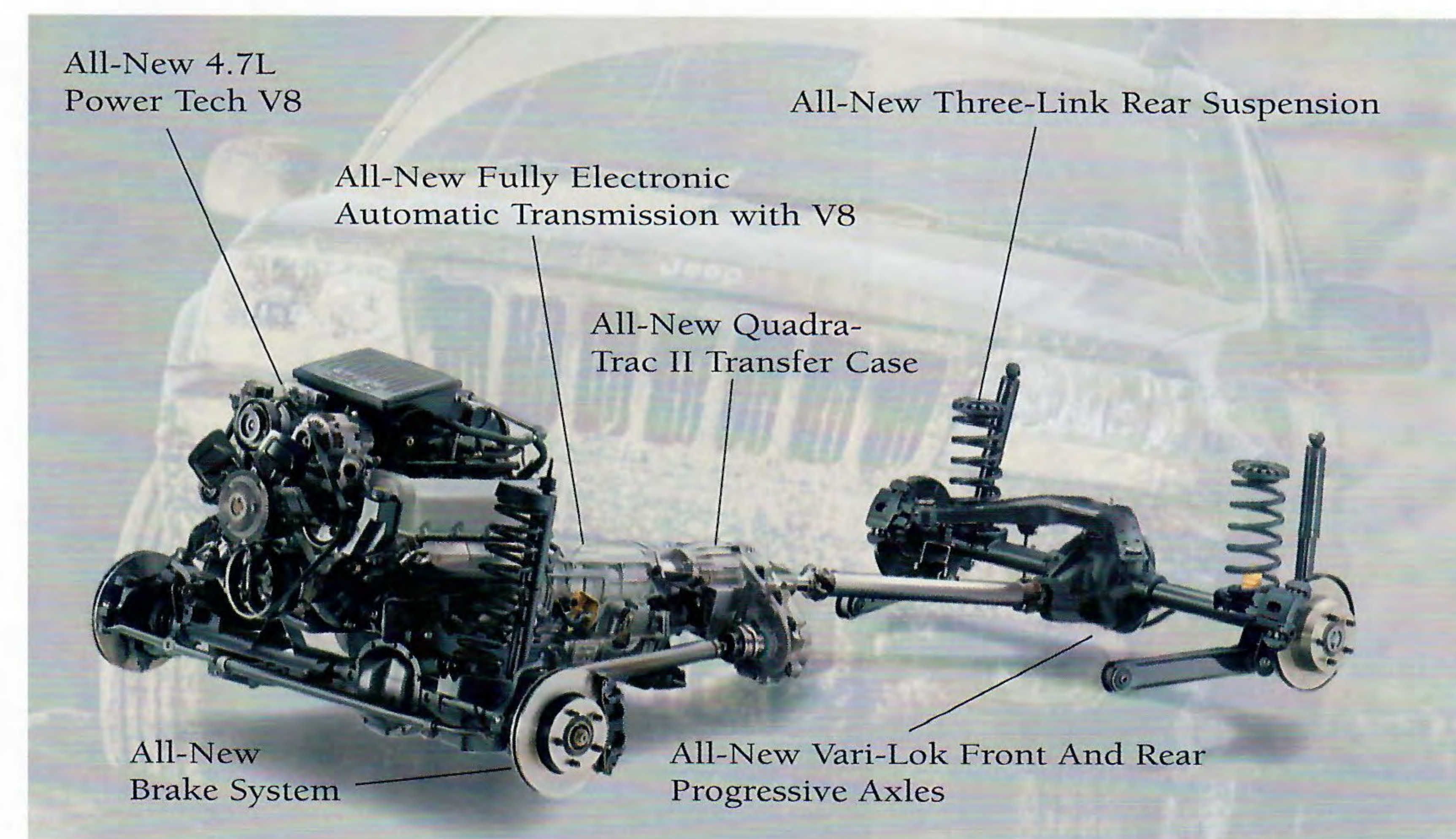
A key element in the Quadra-Drive System is the all-new Quadra-Trac II on-demand transfer case, which transfers torque quickly and quietly between front and rear axles.

Grand Cherokee is the first vehicle ever whose transfer case and available Vari-Lok progressive axles all feature speed-sensing torque-transfer devices. That means torque can be transferred rear to front between axles and side to side on both axles.



1 Two wheels on ice on the same side of the vehicle would mean a call for help in most 4x4s. In a Grand Cherokee equipped with the available Quadra-Drive System, the front and rear progressive axles transfer torque, if necessary, to the wheels with traction, giving you power to continue your journey.

2 Since Quadra-Drive is capable of transferring 100 percent of the developed engine torque to any one wheel, even three wheels on ice would not stop the all-new Grand Cherokee.

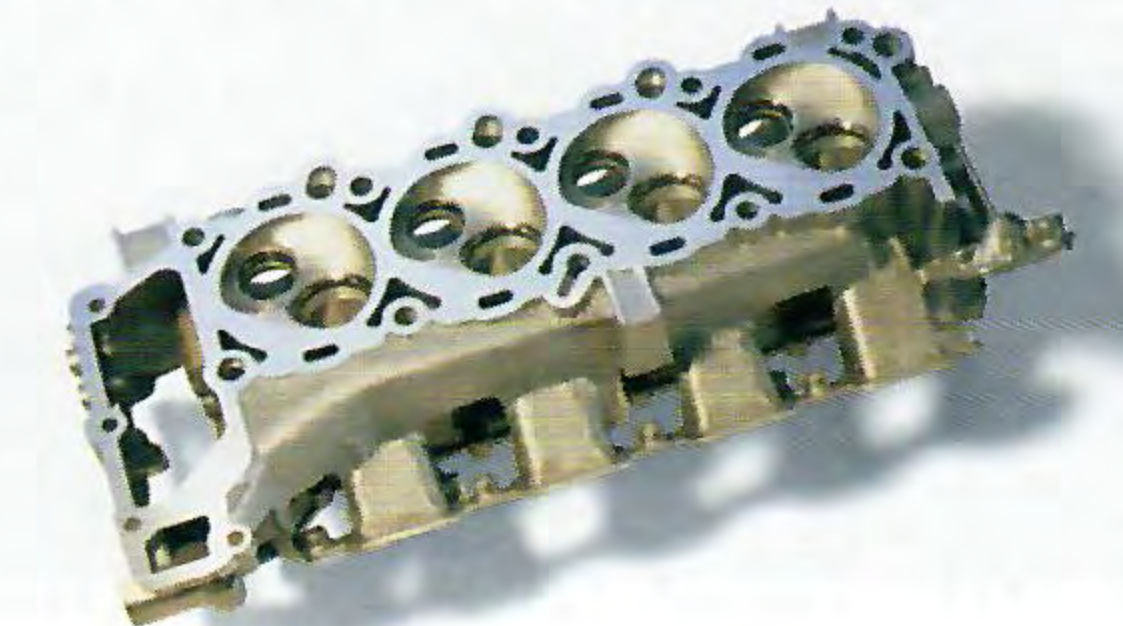

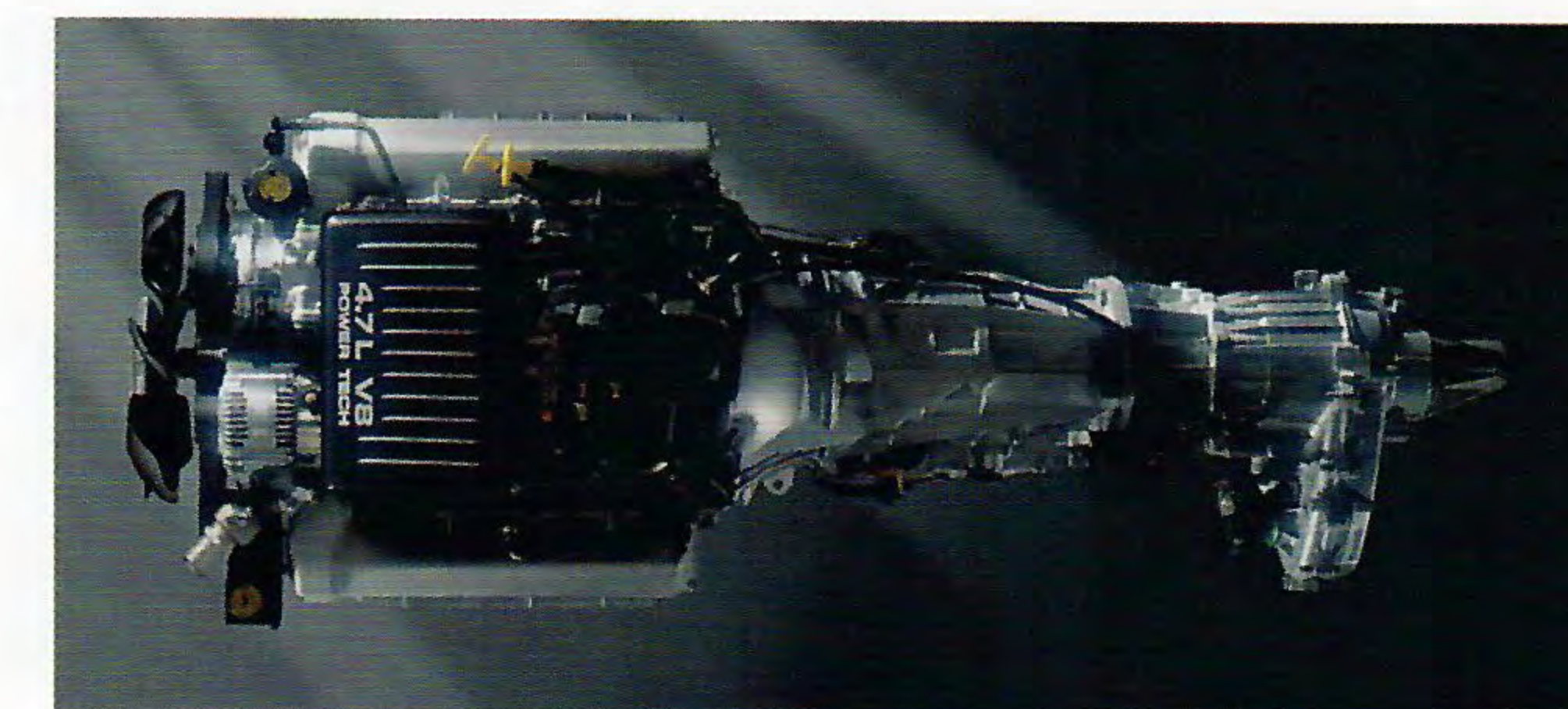

POWER AND PERFORMANCE

Grand Cherokee's Quadra-Coil™ suspension and all-new drivetrain* perform powerfully on- and off-road. With a wide range of gear ratios that includes an alternate second gear to help smooth downshifts, the multispeed 45 RFE (rear-wheel-drive fully electronic) automatic transmission precisely applies the 4.7L Power Tech V8's exceptional might — all 235 horsepower of it. A quieter, more luxurious ride results from the new three-link rear suspension, wider spacing of the tie-rod points, modified coil springs at all four corners and standard 16-inch wheels and tires. And with new steering linkage, gear, and optimized steering geometry, these ride and handling improvements reach the driver more accurately through more precise steering response and improved control from behind the wheel.

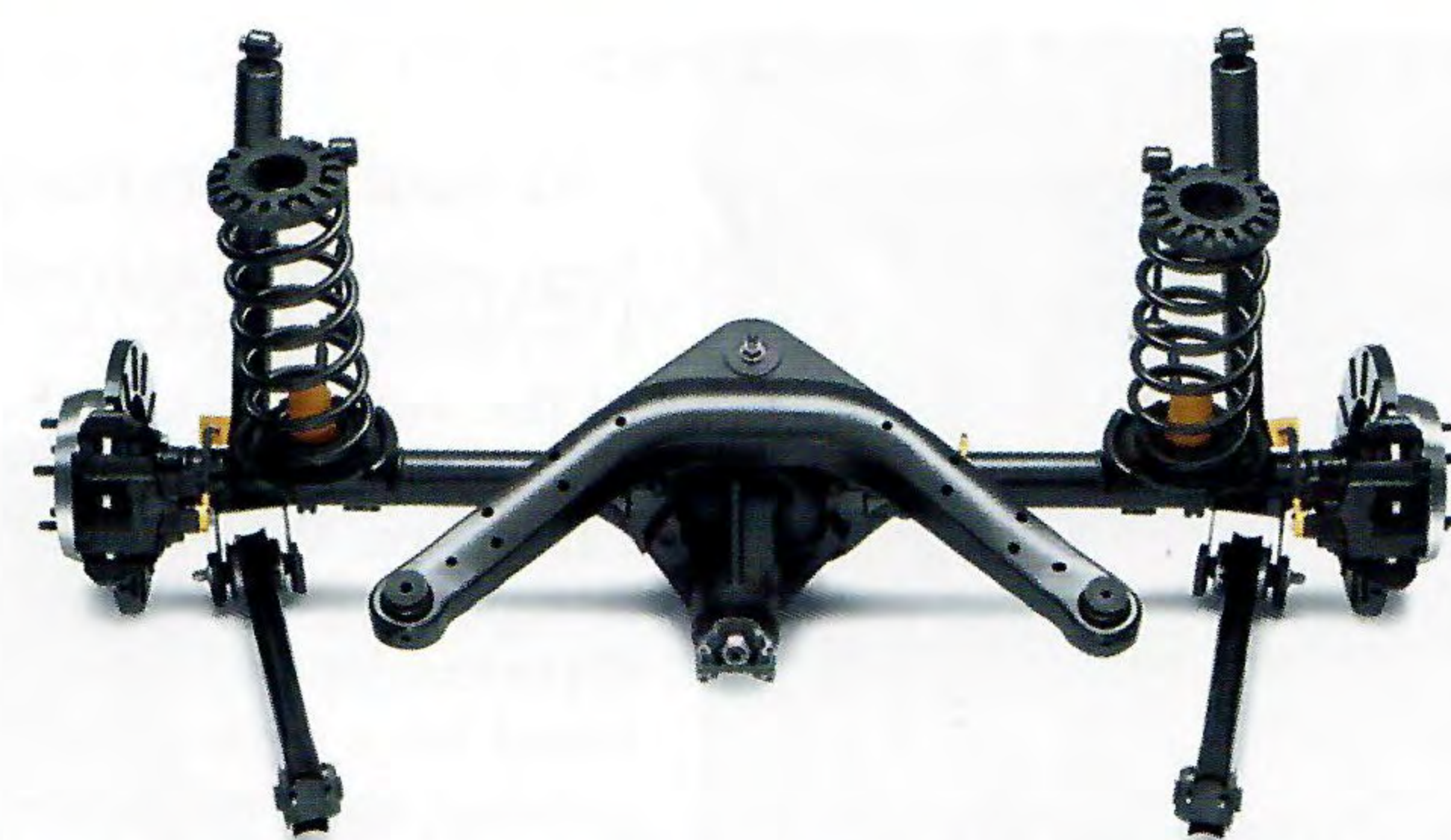

In addition to a running ground clearance of 9.1 inches with the available Up Country Suspension Group, the all-new Grand Cherokee has improved its suspension articulation, allowing for a more comfortable ride both on- and off-road.

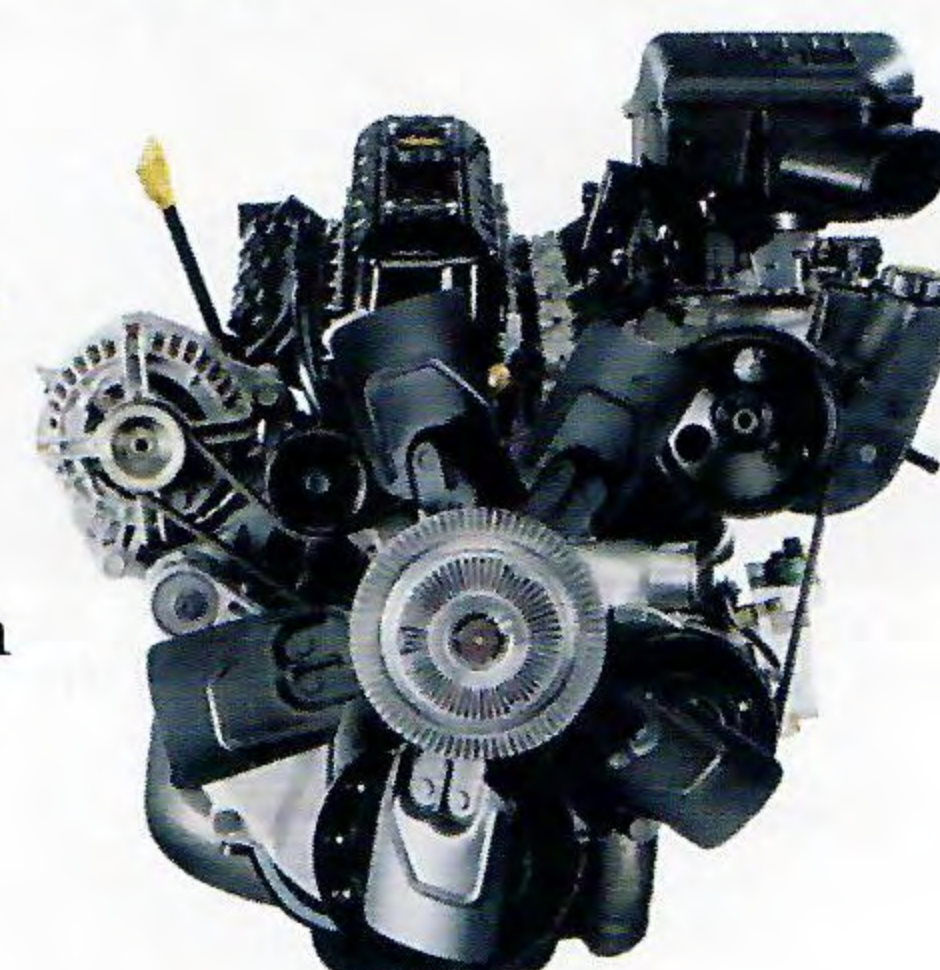


The new quad-halogen headlamps on Grand Cherokee provide a wider beam pattern and greater range than the previous system.

The 4.0L Power Tech I-6 is standard on Laredo and Limited. Enhancements for 1999 have increased output to 195 horsepower and torque to 230 pound-feet. It is teamed with an electronically controlled four-speed automatic transmission.



Grand Cherokee's stiffer, stronger, more durable UniFrame means less resonance (vibration) reaches you in the vehicle, providing smoother travel off-road and better ride and handling on it.

PREMIUM ACCOMMODATIONS

Grand Cherokee's all-new interior really comes together at its focal point — the center.

The instrument panel's center pod contains large, rotary controls for the first-ever Infrared Dual Zone Climate Control system (on Limited models), an auxiliary power outlet and centrally located radio knobs with soft-touch buttons. A floor-mounted center console features dual front and rear cup holders and a large covered storage bin with tissue pack and pen holders molded into the lid's underside. Above center, a HomeLink® Universal Transmitter in Grand Cherokee Limited's overhead console allows you to control your garage door, estate gate and home security system from the driver's seat. All this (and more) innovation can be accessed in one place — Grand Cherokee's comforting interior environment. After all, we designed it for the real center of attention. You.

This can't be said of the many manufacturers who have rushed to enter the sport-utility vehicle market and made concessions to off-road capability: no low-range four-wheel drive, little power, minimal ground clearance. The list goes on. And stops cold with the four-wheel-drive Cherokee. Ample ground clearance, generous approach, departure and breakover angles, a Quadra-Link solid-axle, coil-spring front suspension and UniFrame construction are standard. Axle ratios are geared low enough for off-road mastery. Powerful engines feature loads of low-end torque, and both the Command-Trac® and Selec-Trac® four-wheel-drive systems include low range. Honest, genuine 4x4 freedom — for a lot less than you might imagine. That's Jeep Cherokee for 1999.

OFF-ROAD READINESS

Cherokee's remarkable versatility includes the choice of two proven four-wheel-drive (4WD) systems. Selec-Trac®, standard on 4WD Limited and optional on Classic and Sport (requires 4-speed automatic transmission), is a full-time system with a convenient 4 FULL-TIME mode that can remain engaged over all road surfaces. Command-Trac®, standard on SE, Sport and Classic 4WD models, is a part-time system for use whenever extra traction is required. Up front, Cherokee's Quadra-Link suspension is anchored by a rugged solid axle (beam axle on two-wheel-drive models). Together with coil springs and four locating arms, this setup gives Cherokee precise handling, stability and control on a variety of driving surfaces.



With Selec-Trac (shown) and Command-Trac, you can shift-on-the-fly into high range four-wheel drive at speeds up to 55 mph. For optimum torque and control in severe conditions, both have a four-wheel-drive low range.

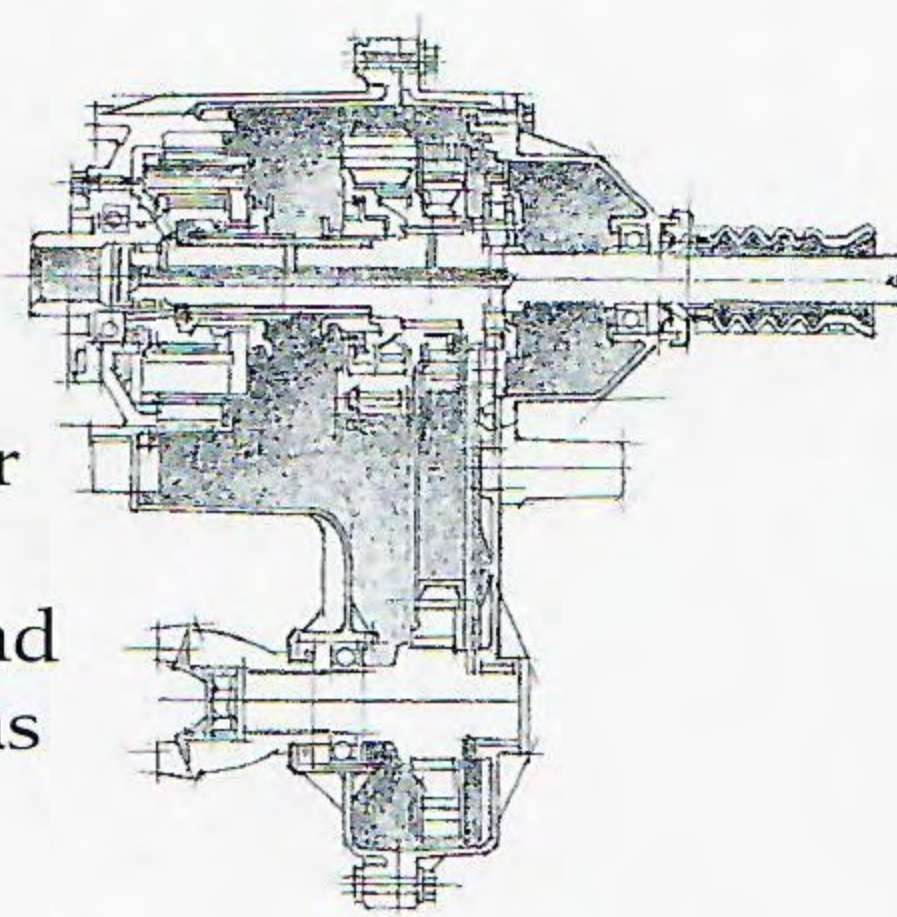


With up to 11.7 inches of minimum running ground clearance and 38.4-degree approach, 31.2-degree departure and 24.5-degree breakover angles, Cherokee can tackle the roughest terrain without the undercarriage making contact with the ground.

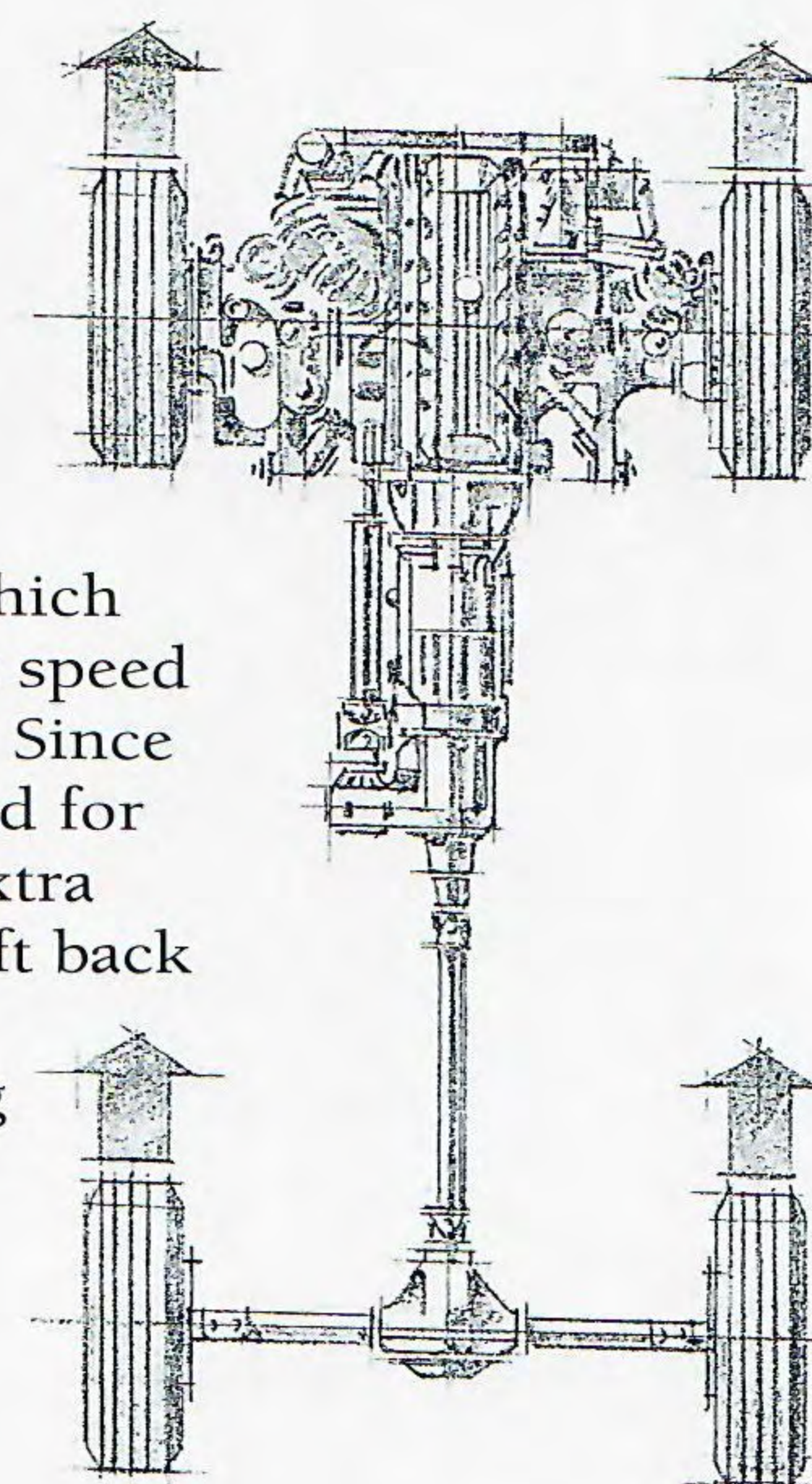

In the Selec-Trac 4 FULL-TIME mode, 48 percent of engine power is sent to the front axle and 52 percent to the rear. Because the driveshafts rotate at different speeds, you have the added convenience of remaining in this mode year-round over any road surface — including dry, paved roads — instead of having to shift back and forth between two- and four-wheel drive as road conditions change.




In the Selec-Trac 4 PART-TIME mode, the center differential mechanically locks the front and rear driveshafts together, which then rotate at the same speed for maximum traction. Since this position is designed for temporary use when extra traction is required, shift back into two-wheel drive (2WD) when returning to dry, paved surfaces.



POWER

For a versatile performer like Jeep® Cherokee, power serves many functions. With the mighty 4.0L Power Tech I-6 engine (standard on Sport, Classic and Limited, optional on SE), there's passing power and quick acceleration for the open road, pulling power for a boat or horse trailer, and plenty of low-end grunt for hardy trail work. That's because its in-line design supplies peak torque (pulling power) at a usable, low-speed range. Transmissions include a five-speed manual standard on SE and Sport, optional three-speed automatic (on two-wheel-drive SE models with the 2.5L Power Tech I-4 engine) or standard four-speed automatic featuring electronic controls and a lockup torque converter on Classic



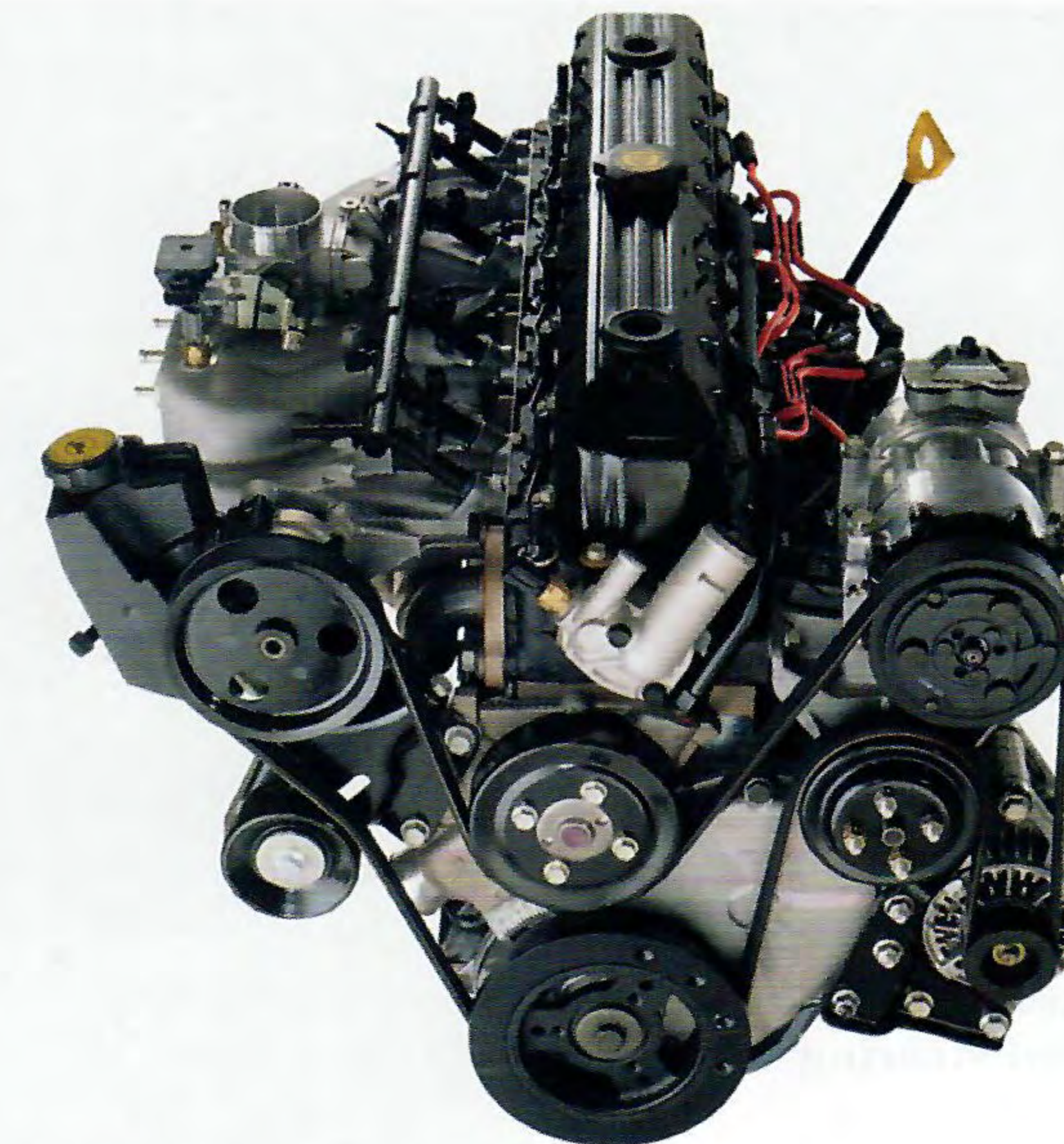
and Limited (optional on SE with the 4.0L Power Tech I-6 engine, and Sport models). With the four-speed automatic transmission and Class IV Trailer Tow Group, the 4.0L Power Tech I-6 allows Cherokee to tow up to 5,000 pounds.



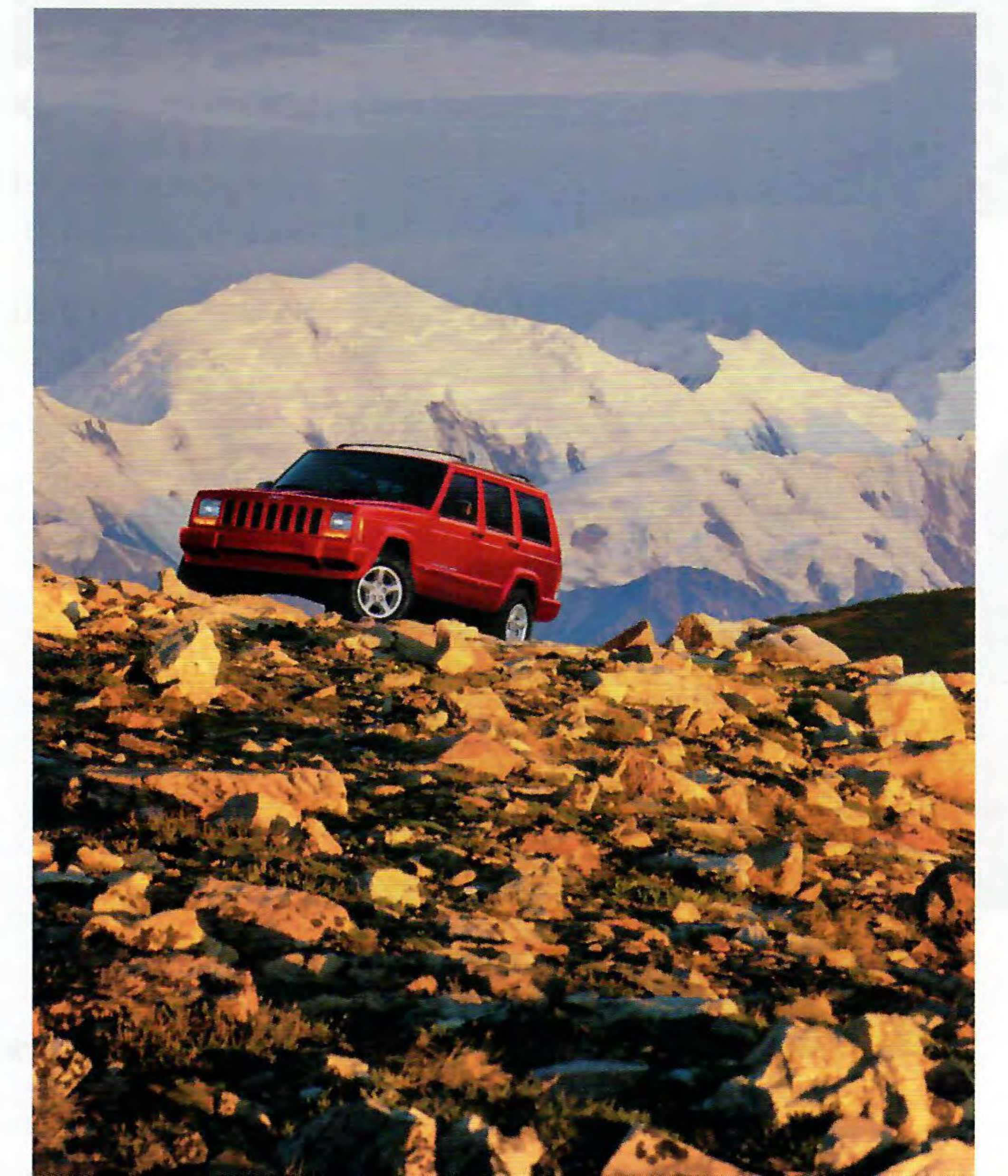

Output for Cherokee's 4.0L Power Tech I-6 engine is 190 horsepower and 225 pound-feet of torque.



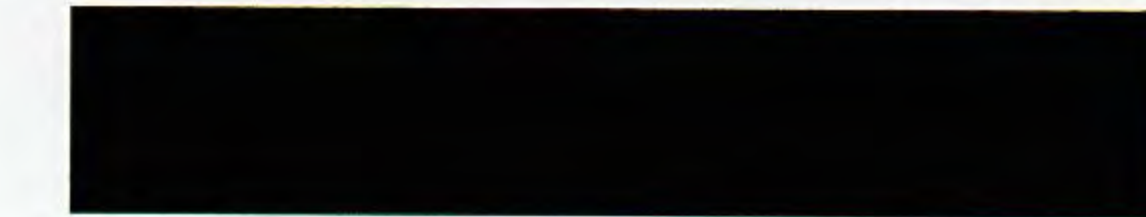


The incredibly rigid, two-piece basic structure of Cherokee's instrument panel (Limited shown) helps keep it quiet inside, even on the bumpiest of trails.

VERSATILITY

What makes Jeep® Cherokee so special is its ability to carry everything you'll need at your destination, over terrain you'd have a hard time crossing on foot. And all that cargo space is easily accessible because the one-piece, all-steel rear liftgate features an interior handle for easy closing. If you run out of room inside, the roof rack (standard on Classic and Limited, optional on SE and Sport) can handle an additional 150 pounds of gear, if needed. As noted in *Automobile Magazine*, "The Cherokee is honest and gimmick free ... with room for bulky cargo and seats for five."

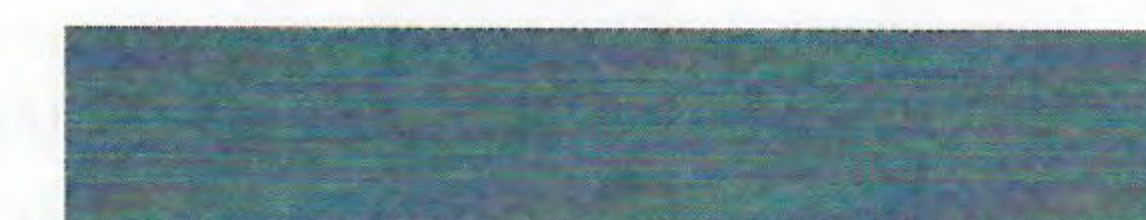

JEEP® WRANGLER

Out there somewhere is a slice of paradise you've seen only in your dreams. Access is limited — only those who own a Jeep Wrangler may enter. Wrangler's go-anywhere attitude is backed by rock-solid credentials. All models are equipped with Command-Trac®, a part-time, shift-on-the-fly 4WD system. Part-time means you only engage 4WD when you need it — off-road or on slick surfaces. Shift-on-the-fly lets you move from 2WD to 4WD high range at speeds up to 55 mph. Wrangler's Quadra-Coil™ suspension soaks up bumps and offers incredible articulation that helps keep all four wheels on the ground in rocky terrain.

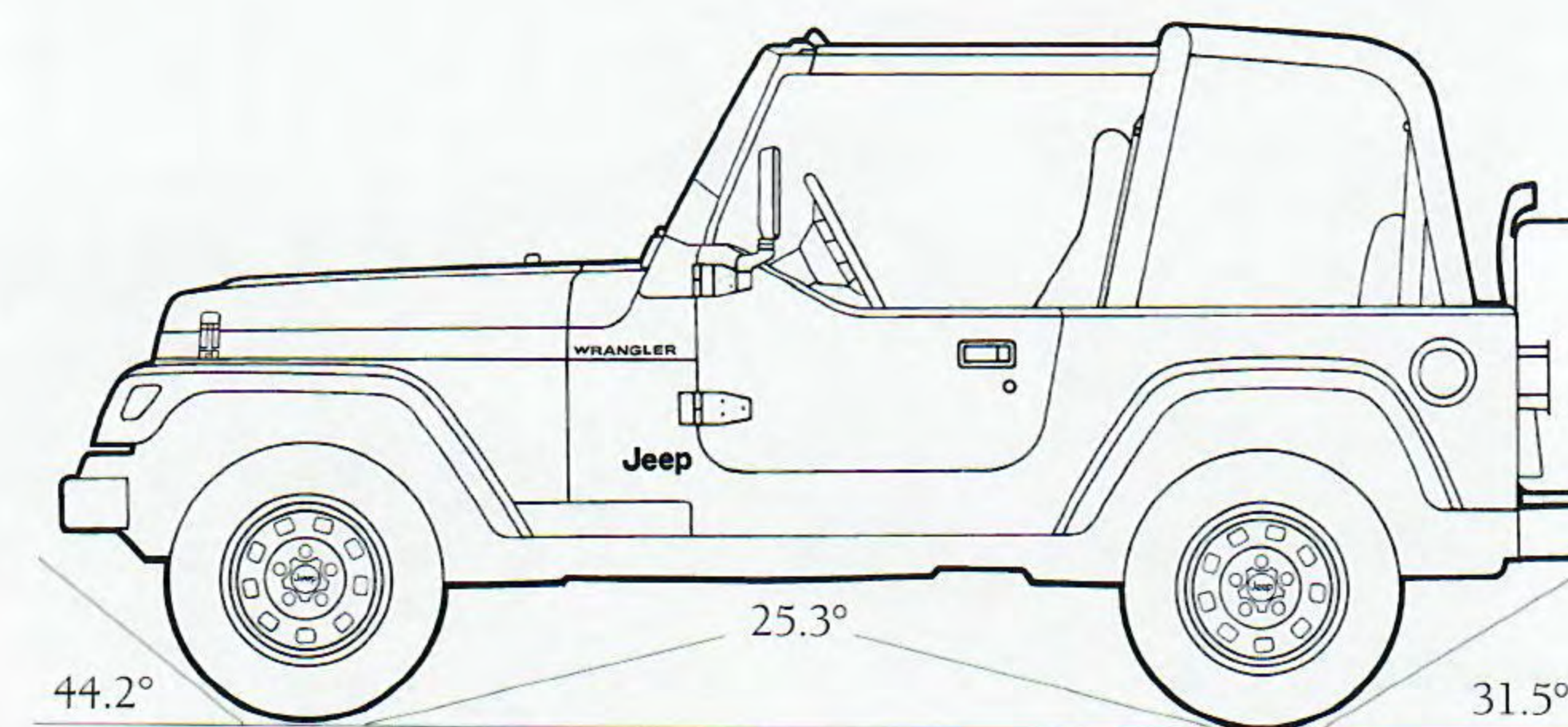
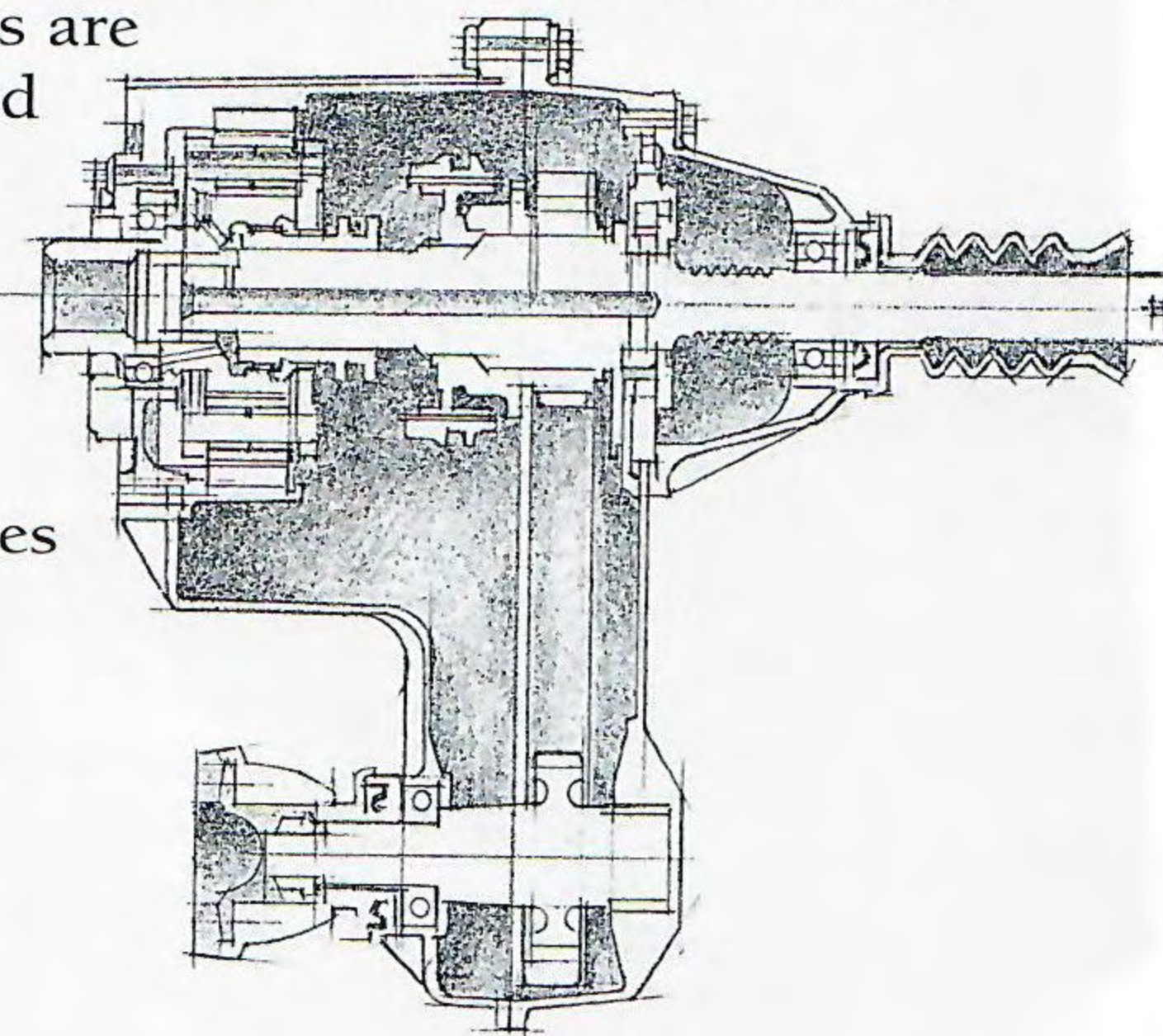

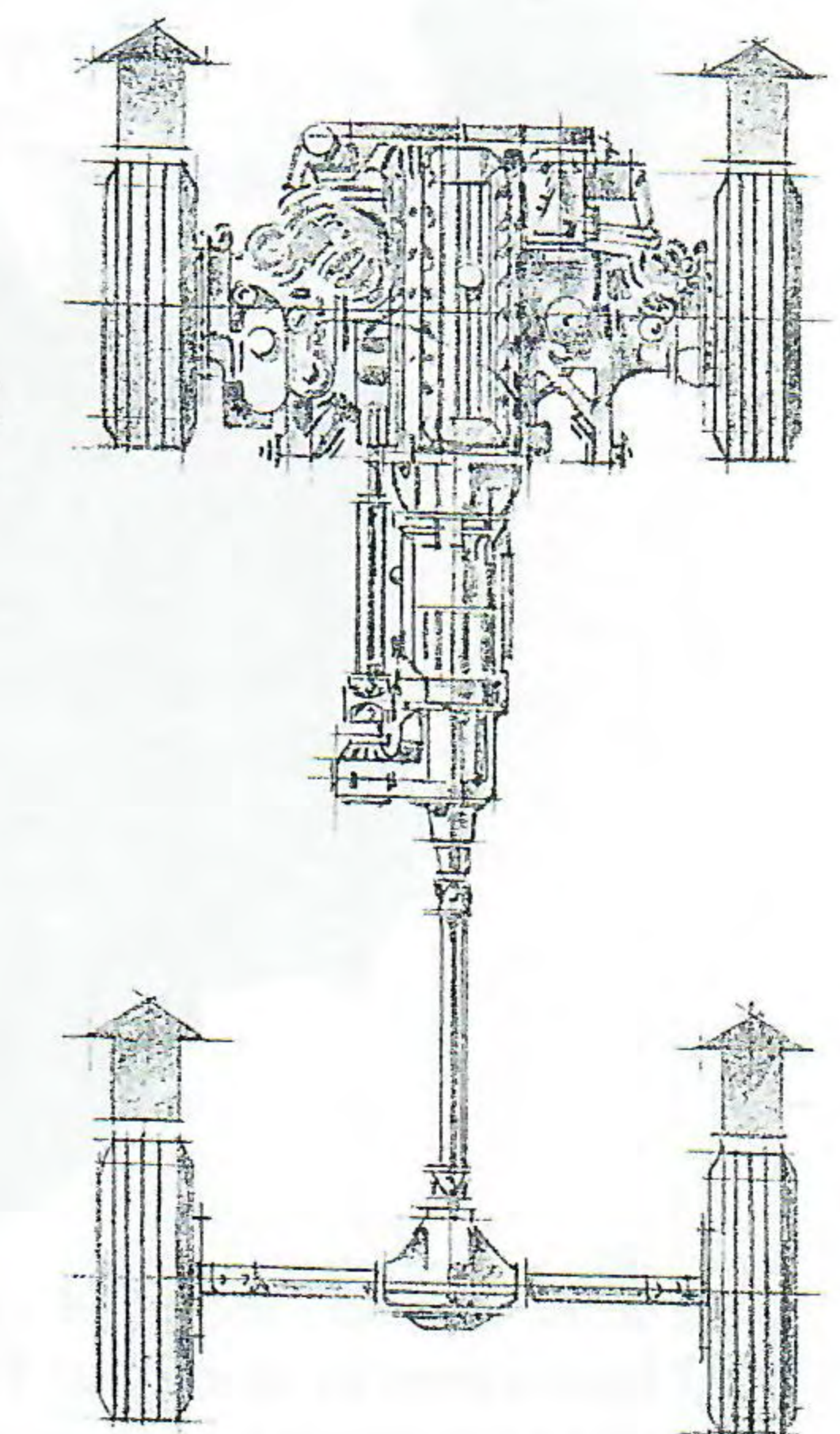

Wrangler's off-road prowess is due in part to its solid Command-Trac transfer case. In 4WD, both front and rear driveshafts are mechanically locked and always turn at the same speed, forming a single driving unit. This is a rigid connection that does not allow for any differential action between front and rear axles.



44.2-degree approach, 31.5-degree departure and 25.3-degree breakover angles help keep Wrangler's undercarriage from coming in contact with the ground while traversing rugged terrain.

In 4WD, the engine's power is split by mechanically locking the front and rear driveshafts together, providing torque to all wheels for maximum traction. Since this mode is only intended for slippery conditions, shift back into 2WD when returning to dry, paved surfaces.



Engage Wrangler's high-range four-wheel drive simply by shifting the Command-Trac lever from 2H to 4H at speeds up to 55 mph.





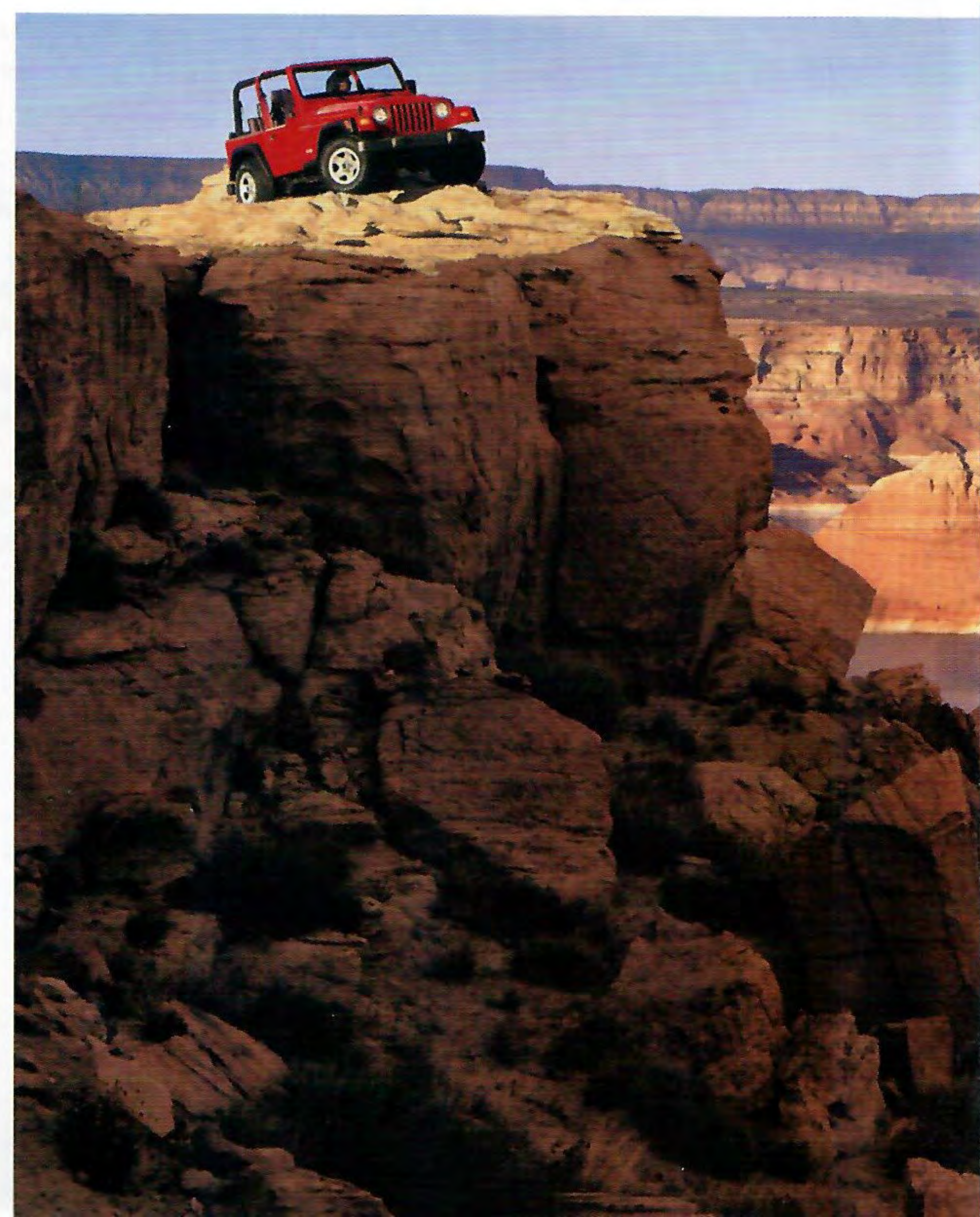

POWER

When the U.S. Army requested “light reconnaissance vehicle” prototypes in 1940, only the Willys-Overland Quad exceeded initial power specifications. That powerful heritage lives on in today’s Wrangler. The 4.0L Power Tech I-6 engine, standard on Sport and Sahara, is one of the most powerful six-cylinder engines in its class, turning out 181 horsepower and 222 lb-ft of torque. The 2.5L Power Tech I-4 engine, standard on Wrangler SE, also delivers lots of low-end capability for crawling over rocks and boulders. A standard five-speed manual or optional three-speed automatic transmission is available with either engine. In addition to the standard 4.0L Power-Tech I-6, the well-equipped, top-of-the-line Sahara also features a standard heavy-duty battery, heavy-duty alternator and two front tow hooks.



The 2.5L Power Tech I-4 engine, standard on SE, delivers 120 horsepower and 140 lb-ft of torque. A five-speed manual transmission is standard and a three-speed automatic is optional.



Both the 2.5L Power Tech I-4 and the 4.0L Power Tech I-6 engines have plenty of torque available at the low-end — a necessity in negotiating severe off-road conditions.

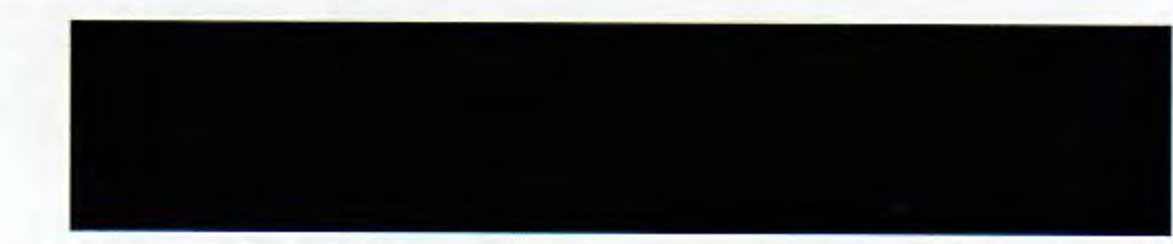

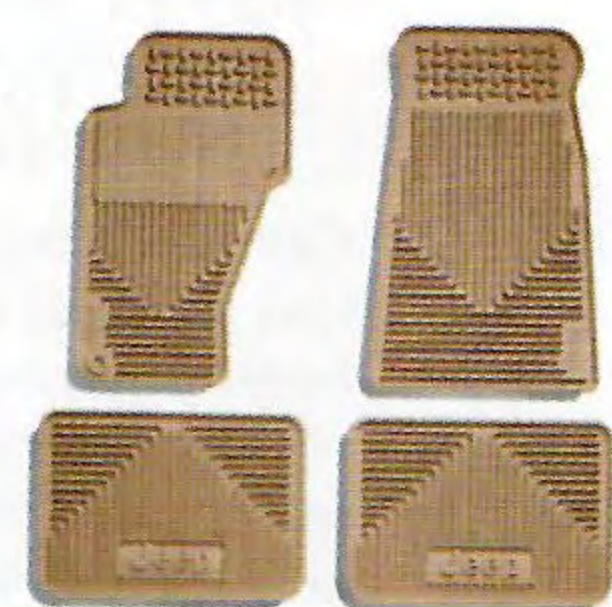

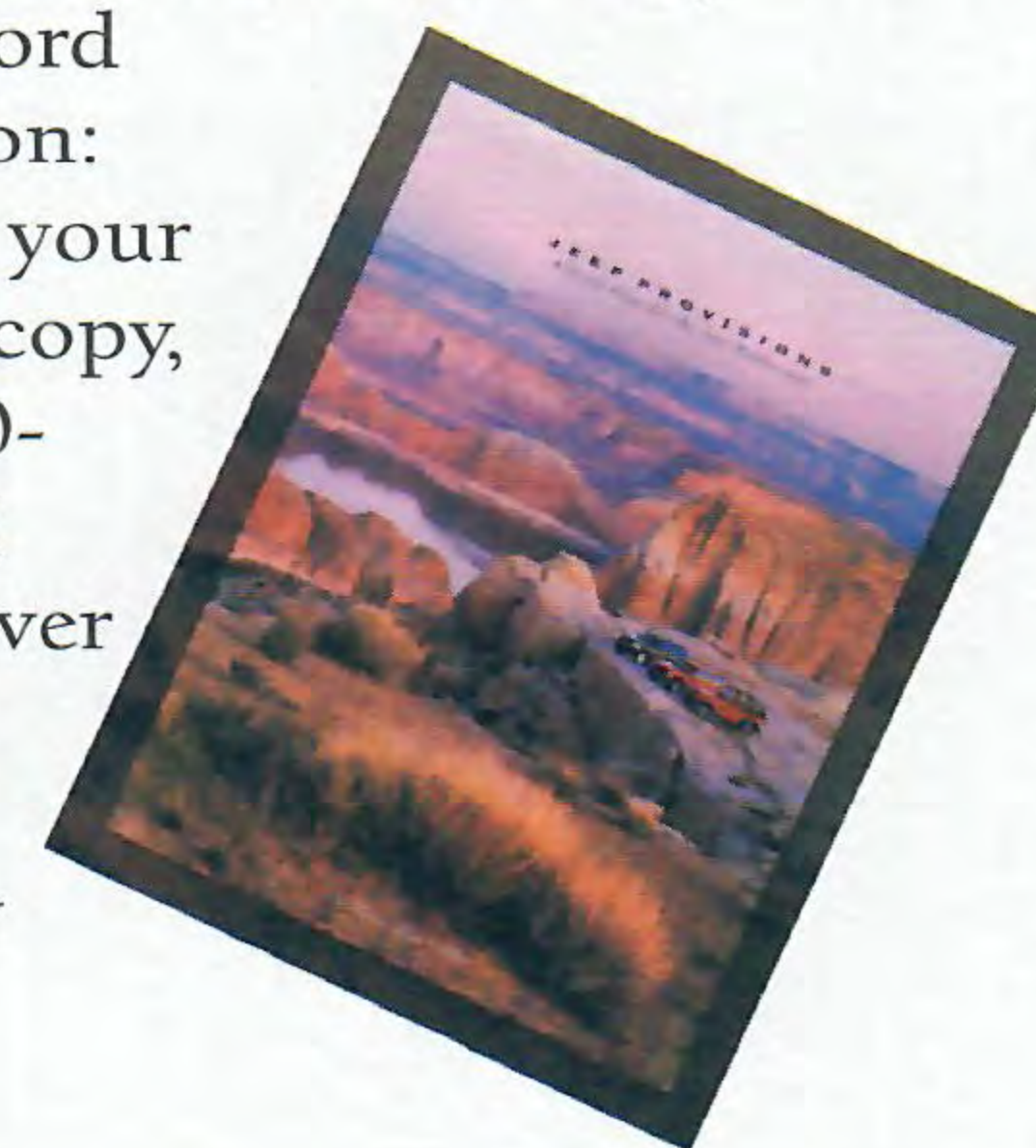
