OVERVIEW:

This Bulletin Involves installing a supplemental antenna to the Electronic Vehicle Information Center (EVIC).

SYMPTOM/CONDITION:

The Universal Garage Door Opener located in the EVIC may have a reduced operating range. A supplemental antenna has been developed which will extend the effective range.

DIAGNOSIS:

If customers complain of reduced range, perform the Repair Procedure.

PARTS REQUIRED:

REPAIR PROCEDURE:

THIS REPAIR IS COMPATIBLE WITH DAIMLERCHRYSLER'S MOBILE SERVICE PROGRAM AND DOES NOT REQUIRE HOISTS OR OTHER FULL SERVICE FACILITY SPECIAL EQUIPMENT.

- 1. Open the hood and disconnect the negative battery cable.
- 2. Remove the overhead console attaching screw.
- 3. Remove the overhead console by pulling it straight down. Use caution not to damage the wire harnesses.
- 4. Disconnect the wire harnesses and remove the console.
- 5. Inspect the overhead console for the presence of a copper wire antenna routed around the perimeter of the housing. If this wire is present, remove and discard it.
- 6. Remove the four EVIC mounting screws from the overhead console and remove the EVIC.
- 7. Peel the protective backing from the antenna, p/n 05015803AA, and install the antenna around the EVIC as shown in Figure 1. Start at the side of the EVIC nearest the C/T Button, using the tabs on the side of the unit as a reference point.
- 8. Install the EVIC into the overhead console.
- 9. Connect the wire harnesses and install the overhead console into the roof panel.
