# **MODELS:**

1999 (WJ) Grand Cherokee

#### SYMPTOM/CONDITION:

Some vehicles may exhibit a water leak at the rear liftgate flipper window. This leak will generally only occur during a car wash utilizing high pressure spray. An improved seal has been developed which will address this condition.

# **DIAGNOSIS:**

If a vehicle exhibits this condition, perform the Repair Procedure.

## **PARTS REQUIRED:**

1 55136053AC Seal, Flipper Glass

## **REPAIR PROCEDURE:**

This bulletin involves replacing the liftgate flipper glass seal.

1. Open the liftgate flipper glass.

NOTE: THE FLIPPER GLASS SEAL UTILIZES A SEALING COMPOUND WITHIN THE SEAL CHANNEL. USE CAUTION WHEN REMOVING THE SEAL. IT MAY BE NECESSARY TO PROTECT THE SURROUNDING TRIM WHEN REMOVING THE SEAL.

2. Clean any sealing compound from the seal flange with MOPAR Superkleen or an appropriate solvent.

3. Install the new seal, P/N 55136053AC, in the opening making sure that the paint dots on the new seal are aligned with the upper corners of the opening.
